



2024 Junior Championship Information:



The SA Regional Junior Championships began in 2001, hosted by the Riverland Hockey Association at Berri. The main objective was, and still is, to promote the growth and development of hockey among juniors in Under 13, Under 16 and Under 19 age divisions within regional associations of South Australia. The Regionals, as they are known, are held each October long weekend on a rotation basis amongst the regional associations.

WHERE: The championship will be held at In Naracoorte in 2024

WHEN: October long weekend 5th -7th October 2024

WHO: All players over the age of 10 and under the age of 19 as of the 1st of Jan. 2023, are eligible to try out, U10's can play but require a permit to do so and are only eligible to play if the under 13's team is short of players. They intend to organize games for any child under the age of 10 participating in the tournament. Further details will be provided later.

COST: There is a minimal cost to play, you are responsible for your accommodation and travel expenses. We have hired the Naracoorte Scout Hall, if you are having trouble finding accommodation. There will be a small cost per person per night. You can bring your own Tent or Caravan or sleep in the hall.

UNIFORM: You will need to supply black skirt or shorts; South Coast will supply shirt and socks to be returned at the end of the weekend (Or you can buy socks from us).

EQUIPMENT: **Supplied by the player/parent.** - Stick, shin guards (compulsory) mouth guard (compulsory), shoes suitable for playing on grass and Turf. Water bottle, hat, sunscreen and top to change into after the last game. Any medical supplies your child needs e.g., strapping tape, allergy medication etc. **Equipment supplied from our local clubs.** - Goal keeping kit and face masks.
